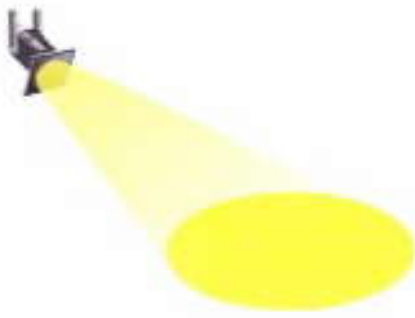
**Pastoral Care**
